



LIFEGUARD AND WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR TRAININGS

The St. Petersburg Parks & Recreation Department offers Lifeguard training classes and Water Safety Instructor training classes.

PREREQUISITES Must pass the required swim test prior to registering for class and be 15 years old for lifeguard training and 16 years old for water safety instructor training by the first class (proof of age required).

TRAINING FEES

- Lifeguard Training: \$160 pool fee (includes \$39 Red Cross fee). Payment due at time of registration. Make checks payable to City of St. Petersburg. *Fee assistance is available for those who qualify. Contact 727-893-7727 for details.*
- Water Safety Instructor Training: \$39 Red Cross fee at registration and payable to the Red Cross via hyperlink provided by instructor.
