



CAMPING RULES & REGULATIONS

Check in: 3 p.m. Check out: 12 p.m.
Quiet hours: 10 p.m. - 7 a.m.

PARKING

- Two vehicles per campsite.
- Additional vehicles must park in the main parking lot.
- All vehicles must remain on approved driving surfaces.
- A gate code will be provided at check in for entering and exiting the campground between 11 p.m. - 7 a.m.

The following are **NOT** permitted in the campground:

- Alcoholic beverages
- Smoking or vaping
- Fishing or hunting
- Swimming
- Pets
- Gasoline-powered generators
- Feeding or harassing wildlife
- RVs or campers
- Outside firewood*

**Firewood is available for purchase at Hammock Hall.*

CAMPFIRES

- Must be confined to designated pits.
- No cutting or collecting of firewood.
- Firewood, if available, will be sold at Hammock Hall.

GARBAGE

- Dispose of trash in the garbage can closest to your campsite.
- Recycling containers are located near the dumpster.

CAMPSITES

- The registered camper is responsible for activities at their designated site.
- Registered campers must be 18 years of age.
- Campers must sleep in approved campsites.
- Please do not remove tables from sites.
- Visitors are not permitted in the campground between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Secure valuables. The City of St. Petersburg is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.
- Service animals must be registered at the office at the time of check in and always remain on a leash.

TRAIL ACCESS

- Pedestrian trails are accessible to all registered campers.
- Trail access will be reduced at dusk.
- Motorized vehicles are prohibited on trails.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- In the event of an emergency, call 911.
- Staff will be available on-site from 7 a.m. - 11 p.m.
- For questions, concerns or nonemergencies, between 7 a.m. and 11 p.m., call 727-893-7326.
